#### HISTORY OF THE SALESIAN SOCIETY OF DON BOSCO



The Salesian Society, founded by DON BOSCO, is a world - wide educational organisation with many Schools, Colleges, Agricultural & Technical Schools and Youth Centers throughout the world.

The founder of all these educational institutions of the most varied kinds is John Bosco who was born in a little village in Northern Italy in 1815. By hardwork and persevering efforts he became a Priest and dedicated his life to the welfare of the poor and abandoned youth. His ideas were so far ahead of his times that he was considered revolutionary. He opened a youth centre, organized evening classes for working boys, taught them trades, and made them good and honest citizens.

"Work is prayer" was Don Bosco's motto. To continue his good work, he invited helpers and founded a Congregation which he called "Salesians" named after St. Francis de Sales. Today he is known the world - over as Don Bosco. He died on 31<sup>st</sup> January 1888. Today Don Bosco Institution are established in 130 countries.

#### **RULES OF THE SCHOOL**

## 1. School Uniform

The school uniform is compulsory on all working days and at school functions. Students must come to school clean and tidy.

#### 2. Punctuality and Attendance

Students must be punctual for class. Latecomers should get the permission of the Principal before entering the classroom. No student may absent himself without obtaining prior permission. They should check and report through students' Handbook.

#### 3. Leave Letter Procedure

All students from LKG to class 12 must submit a leave letter upon returning after an absence. Students of classes 6 to 12 must write the leave letter on their own and submit the same neatly (leave letter pad will not be provided by the school). Whereas, parents may write and send the leave letter for KG and classes 1 to 5. The leave letter must be signed by the parent and countersigned by the designated school authority as listed below :

- Classes KG to 8 ( 1 or 2 days ) Class Teachers
- Classes KG to 8 ( 3 days & more ) Vice Principal
- Classes 9 to 12 ( 1 day & more) Principal

A student absenting himself from school due to sickness for 5 days in succession without permission needs to produce a genuine doctor's certificate. The Application for leave must be given in advance. When for unforeseen reasons, one is absent, the application for leave should be submitted on the day of rejoining the school. Leave letters shall be maintained by the respective class teachers.

Attendance at official school meetings, Sports Day Annual Day is compulsory for students and parents.

## 4. Homework / Handwriting

Parents are expected to cooperate in the work of the school by enforcing regularity, punctuality and discipline, and by taking daily interest in the progress of their children. They should check and report through Student's Profile and enforce handwriting daily and follow up homework schedule through the class Whatsapp group.

## 5. Periodic Tests/Exams/Open Day

Three Periodic Tests will be conducted in the months of July, August & December while Half Yearly Assessment & Yearly Assessment will take place in September and March respectively. Students must acccompany the parents on Open Days in proper school uniform with the school hand book.

#### 6. School Fees

- Every student, including the newly admitted, will have to pay the fees of the academic year. If a student leaves the school during the year, he shall have no right to claim a remission of any portion of the fees.
- 2. Fees are to be paid before the school reopens. The amount payable as fees is subject to revision, even

with retrospective effect within a school year, as circumstances warrant.

3. All fees are to be paid Online .

## 7. Promotions

All matters regarding the promotion of the students are left to the discretion of the Principal and the Promotion Committee, whose decision will be final. A student who fails for two years in succession will not be allowed to continue in the school.

## 9. Discipline

Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, negligence of homework, disobedience and disrespect towards members of the staff, or bad moral influence, justify dismissal. Students are responsible to the school authorities for their conduct both inside and outside the school.

## **10. Protection of School Property**

The students are responsible for maintaining the neatness of the benches and desks in their are classroom. They are forbidden to write or scribble anything on the wall, door, benches and desks. If any damage is caused at anytime, they are bound to pay for it as per the decision of the Principal.

## 11. School Handbook

The school Handbook is the record concerning the school and student. Therefore, every student must bring it to the school daily. If any one loses it, he must apply for a new one.

#### 12. Rule of Language

- 1. The medium of instruction is English. Students are expected to communicate only in English all time in the school premises.
- 2. The second and third Languages taught in the school are Tamil and Hindi. German is the additional Language.
- 3. Speaking in English is compulsory in the school.

#### **14. Concerning Defaulters**

For issues of repeated indiscipline, late coming, irregularities, disobedience, failure to bring notebooks or textbooks, wearing inappropriate dress and improper hair style, students will be sent back home if corrections are not carried out.

#### **15.Examinations**

Students who absent themselves from any examination with or without grave reasons will have no chance of re-exam. The marks obtained in all exams throughout the year will be taken into consideration along with the Annual Exam marks for promotion.

Indulgence in malpractice in Tests and Exams will be warned for the first time and if the practice continues, he will be automatically dismissed from the school at the end of the current academic year.

Students who are caught copying during any test or examination may be detained or asked to leave the School, irrespective of their academic performance.

Books or papers of any kind should not be brought to the Examination Hall by the students. Every student should have the required stationery materials. No lending or borrowing is permitted in the Examination Hall.

Absolute Silence is to be maintained in the Examination Hall. Students who make use of unfair means during examination will be severely dealt with at the discretion of the Principal. Those who help others in anyway to have recourse to unfair means will also be dealt with in the same manner.

Tests and Examinations should be taken on the specified days. No separate test will be conducted for absentees.

Well done certificate are awarded to students who score 90% and above in major tests and exams , while merit certificates are given to those who score 75% and above.

#### 16. Private Tuition

- 1. The school does not encourae private tuition.
- 2. No tuitions would be held in the school premises.

#### 17. House System :

- To promote competition and healthy rivalry among students in all the activities of the school, House system is followed. Every student is a member of one of the four Houses, namely, Bosco, Savio, Rua and Thomas. The winning House will hoist its flag on every Wednesday of the week.
- 2. Points are awarded to the houses that excel in sports, cultural activities and academics.
- The Co-curricular activities include NCC, Scouts , Cubs, Bunnies , Literary Clubs, Hobby and Eco Club.

#### 18. Admission and Withdrawals :

- 1. Admissions are done by the Rector and His Council in accordance with the admission policy of the Province.
- 2. If the candidate seeks admission, then admission procedures of the institution have to be followed.
- 3. No new admission will be permitted in class X & XII.
- 4. Application for obtaining TC shall be made in writing to the Principal by the one who has signed the admission register at the time of admission. If any other person applies for TC, legal procedures have to be followed.
- 5. A letter must be submitted if admission is sought for UKG to class 9 in the month of January.

#### 19. Parent - Teacher Association (PTA) :

All the parents and teachers of the school are members of this association. The aims of this association are :

1. To make the parents involve themselves actively in the various activities of the school.

- 2. To acquaint the parents with the emerging methods of education, seminars and cultural workshops are conducted. This organization enables them to co-operate with the teachers in moulding the total personality of the children. Meetings will be held occasionally. Parents' attendance at these meetings is solicited.
- 3. PTA executive members are selected by the school authorities. They function as advisory committee members to help the school effectively.
- 4. Suggestions offered by the executive members are not final decisions until they are approved of by the management.

#### 20. The Past Students' Association

The Federation of Don Bosco Past Students is a worldwide organization through which the past students of all Salesian institutions of the world are united.

The Past Students Association of St. Bede's Academy is affiliated to the Provincial, National and World Federation of Don Bosco Past Students. Every student of St. Bede's Academy is automatically enrolled to PPA before he leaves the school.

#### 21. School Dress Code & Code of Conduct

- Students are expected to come to school in proper uniform. Students can come in formal coloured dress on their birthdays and days specified by the Principal.
- 2. Parents are requested to see that their children do not wear ornaments or bring jewellery of any kind to school.

- 3. Students are not permitted to wear any external sign such as special dress, wristband, thread around the wrist, earrings, sacred ash on the forehead, etc which are directly associated with any religion.
- 4. Every student should be neatly dressed with proper and formal hairstyle. Shoes must be polished. Nails must be neatly clipped. Dyeing of hair, wearing earrings, French beard and any form of undesirable hair style are strictly banned.
- 5. Use of chewing gum is banned in the School premises.
- 6. Students should take care of their books and belongings.
- 7. Parents are requested to see that their children do not wear ornaments or bring jewellery of any kind to school.
- They must not bring any electronic gadgets, mobile, camera, memory stick, laser lights, magazines, etc
   It is not advisable to bring money or valuables to school. If they are brought, they will be confiscated and will not be returned.
- 9. No student is allowed to drive a car or a two wheeler to school or inside the school campus.
- 10. Students are not allowed to meet parents or to leave the school premises during school hours without the permission of the Principal.
- 11. When there is a quarrel or fight among the students, the matter must be brought to the notice

of the P.E.T masters, Vice Principal and Principal immediately.

- 12. In the absence of the teacher, the class leader or the assistant class leader immediately takes charge of the class.
- 13. No one may take up any collection of money or impose a fine. No presentation of gifts should be done to teachers either by the parents or students.
- 14. Students are forbidden to be members of any political organization or any club or association outside the school.
- 15. It is compulsory to participate in the co-curricular activities of the school. Every student should choose a recognized game or sport and be trained in it, while at school. Everyone should belong to any one club of the school.
- 16. In case of any change of residential address or mobile number of parents, it should be intimated to the school office without delay.

#### 22. LIBRARY

- As reading habit is very essential for learning and acquiring knowledge, students are encouraged to take the maximum advantage of the School Library.
- 2. Timings : All working days from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm.
- 3. Each student will get one general library card.

- 4. Every student enrolled in the school should have the Library card. Books will be issued or renewed only if the student produces the identity card.
- 5. Library Cards are NON TRANSFERABLE.
- 6. Strict silence shall be observed in the library.
- 7. Books must not be earmarked or defaced.
- 8. If any book or computer is damaged, the whole cost shall be borne by the student concerned.
- 9. Date labels shall not be tampered with.
- 10. All books and Library Cards shall be returned at the end of the academic year on the date specified by the librarian. Library books will not be lent to either students or staff during the annual vacation.

### 23. BEHAVIOUR IN LABS

- 1. Without the prior permission of the teacher or the lab attender, students are not allowed to enter the laboratory.
- 2. Students must not play with or waste chemicals.
- Students must observe absolute silence while they are in the labs. Lab equipments to be handled with care.
- 4. Splashing or wasting water is considered an irresponsible act.
- 5. Burners when not in use must be turned off.
- 6. If chemicals spill over during heating or transfer, the place must be cleaned at once with a towel.

- 7. When a test tube or any apparatus is broken the lab attender must be informed.
- 8. While leaving the lab, student must ensure that the burners and the electrical appliances are switched off.

#### 24. GUIDELINES TO PARENTS

- 1. We believe in the dictum that PARENTS ARE THE FIRST TEACHERS AND THE TEACHERS ARE THE SECOND PARENTS.
- 2. Parents are specially requested to read the rules carefully and see that they are followed. All official dealings can be done through the school office
- 3. Kindly discourage your child from taking leave as far as possible.
- 4. Go through your child's diary daily, to check whether there is a message for you and countersign it.
- 5. Keep in touch with the day to day progress of your child and discuss it with the Principal regularly at the appointed hours.
- 6. Criticism of a student's teacher or the school in the presence of the child should be avoided.
- Only English should be spoken in the school premises in order to obtain a command over spoken English. Parents are requested to encourage this practice at home also.
- 8. The school organizes Parent- Teacher meetings, in which, talks are arranged on child education and

child welfare. Attendance of at least one of the parent in such meetings is compulsory.

- Parents / Guardians may meet the teachers or the children only after obtaining permission from the Principal. They are requested not to enter unnecessarily and disturb classes.
- 10. The entrusting of a student to the school implies that the parents agree to abide by the rules and regulations and decision of the school. Parents should see that their children prepare home lessons properly and devote at least 2 -3 hours in the evenings to their studies.
- 11. As Education is primarily the responsibility of the parents, they are expected to co-operate with the school community with regard to student's integral growth. Therefore, parents are requested to follow up the child in his process of growth and maintain a cordial, cooperative relationship with the school authorities.
- 12. Parents are requested not to speak to the teachers during school hours. Parents who seek information or wish to complain should do so to the Principal and not to the teachers.

#### **25. GUIDELINES TO STUDENTS:**

 Read the school handbook carefully and bring it to school every day. Use it to note down anything you find important.

- 2. This is your school. Keep it clean and tidy so that you and others may be proud of it.
- 3. Converse in English. Encourage your friends to do the same.
- 4. Aim at full attendance and unfailing punctuality.
- 5. Inculcate good values and imbibe good qualities of honesty and sincerity
- 6. Do not leave the classroom or school compound without prior permission.
- 7. Take care of the school property. This is your second home.
- 8. You will be fined for damages at the discretion of the school authorities.
- 9. Read good books and cultivate good manners.
- 10. Be systematic in everything you do.
- 11. Prepare a schedule, allotting time for work as well as play.
- 12. Read the newspaper daily. It will keep you aware of what is needed in the highly competitive world of today.
- 13. Never give up till you succeed. Untiring effort is the need of the hour.
- 14. You are master of the unspoken word and slave of the spoken word.
- 15. Each one of us have been created for a definite purpose. So identify your talent, interest and develop it relentlessly.
